Field label	Definition	Type	Allows Multiples
Main Caption*	A caption for the image. This appears below the image in the gallery view.	short text	

<b>Type*</b>	The type of image.	controlled vocabulary	
<b>Collection</b>	The Mandala collection for this image. Collections help you group and organize your images. The dropdown includes all Mandala collections where you have permission to add images. Learn how to <a href="#">create Image Collections</a> .	controlled vocabulary	
<b>Visibility*</b>	Privacy settings for your image.	controlled vocabulary	
<b>Image Agents</b>	<p>An <b>Agent</b> is a type of structured data in Mandala that describes a person.</p> <p>Learn more at <a href="#">Use Agents</a>. The <a href="#">table below</a> describes each field for an agent. You need at least one agent per image.</p>		✓

### Image Agents

Field Label	Definition	Type
<b>Agent Name*</b>	The name of the person.	short text
<b>Agent Role</b>	The person's role in relation to the image.	controlled vocabulary
<b>Agent Rough Date</b>	<p>An approximate date. Unlike the <b>Agent Exact Dates(s)</b>, they don't have to be in the MM/DD/YYYY format.</p> <p><b>Example:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1947?</li> <li>• 1800s</li> <li>• 300 CE</li> </ul>	short text
<b>Show End Date?</b>	If this is checked, you can add an end date to <b>Agent Exact Date(s)</b> (see below).	boolean
<b>Agent Exact Date(s)</b>	A date associated with the person. This can be a range of dates (for example, birth and death dates). Use the MM/DD/YYYY format.	date
<b>Agent Place(s)</b>	Place(s) associated with this person. This can include places of birth, death, important life events, and more. This field uses Knowledge Maps.	kmap
<b>Notes on this Agent</b>	Any other information you want to add about the agent.	long text

<b>Image Descriptions</b>	A description of the image. Each description has several parts, which you can see in <a href="#">the table below</a> .		✓
<b>Image Notes</b>	Any other information for the image. This information is publicly available.	long text  (WYSIWYG or plain text)	
<b>Admin Notes</b>	Information on the image for project collaborators. Only people with edit permissions will see this text.	long text  (WYSIWYG or plain text)

Field label	Definition	Type	Allows Multiples
<b>Caption</b>	The title for the description.	short text	
<b>Summary</b>	A short summary of the description. <b>Maximum length:</b> 750 characters.	short text	
<b>Description</b>	Information that describes the image.  <b>Maximum length:</b> 750 characters.	long text  (WYSIWYG or plain text)	
<b>Language</b>	The language of the description. This field uses <a href="#">Knowledge Maps</a> .	kmap	
<b>Description Author (s)</b>	The authors of the description.	short text	✓

## Classification

Field label	Definition	Type	Allows Multiples
<b>Subjects</b>	A subject <a href="#">Knowledge Map</a> associated with an image. You can include more than one subject.	kmap	✓
<b>Places</b>	A place <a href="#">Knowledge Map</a> associated with the image. This might represent where the image was made, places referenced in the image, and more. You can include more than one place.	kmap	
<b>KMap Collections</b>	A subject <a href="#">Knowledge Map</a> that represents the overarching project or collection. You can include more than one collection.	kmap	
<b>Other Classification</b>	Classification fields from schemes outside of Mandala. This can include Library of Congress subject headings, geographical names from the Getty Thesaurus, and more. You can contact <a href="mailto:mandala@virginia.edu">mandala@virginia.edu</a> to add your own scheme.		✓

### Technical Details

Field label	Definition	Type	Allows Multiples
<b>Only Digital</b>	Select this if your image was created digitally. If this is checked, the image doesn't represent a physical object that was scanned or photographed.	boolean	
<b>Image Rotation</b>	The original rotation for the image. This does not rotate the image, it just represents how the uploaded image has been rotated from the "right-side-up" perspective.	controlled vocabulary	
<b>Quality</b>	The quality of the image.	<a href="#">controlled vocabulary</a>	
<b>Color</b>	The color of the image (color or black & white)	controlled vocabulary	
<b>Physical size</b>	The size of the original physical artifact. Use width x height x depth, followed by the abbreviation for the unit of measurement.  <b>Example:</b> 10 x 5 cm.	short text	
<b>Capture device</b>	The device used to create the image or digitize the artifact.	short text	
<b>Materials</b>	Materials used in the original physical object, if applicable.	long text (plain text)	
<b>Enhancement</b>	Any enhancements done to the image after it was created or digitized.	long text (plain text)	
<b>Technical Notes</b>		long text  (WYSIWYG or plain text)

<b>Copyright Statement</b>	A short note that describes the nature of the copyright.  <b>Example:</b> All Rights Reserved.	long text (plain text)	
<b>Rights Notes</b>	Any additional notes on the copyright.	long text  (WYSIWYG or plain text)
