Mandala Sources at sources.shanti.virginia.edu is a citation manager. It helps you create, organize, and share your citations.

Mandala Sources interacts with other media in the Mandala Suite. This distinguishes it from other citation managers like Zotero. You can add citations to asset descriptions, collection pages, and more.

You can also label Mandala sources with Mandala Subjects and Places. This links sources to sound, video, text, and visualization assets. Learn more about [Subjects, Places, and Terms in Mandala](#).

Getting started is easy. You log in with your NetBadge computing id and password. Once you've logged in, you can create your first collection and start adding citations.
