

Child Page

In Mandala Texts, a **child page** of a page is a subpage or section that falls under the page. A top page can have many child pages, also called *children*. For example, in the table of contents below, "Introduction," "Chapter 1," and "Conclusion" are children (or child pages) of "Book."
