Add Passages

A passage is a quote from a text that explains the term, or shows how the term is used.

You can add passages to a definition or an entire term. Passages can also include citations from Mandala Sources.

Add a passage to an entire term

- 1. Open the term in the editor view
- 2. Click Passages, then New Passage
 - The passage form will open
- 3. Enter the text of the passage
- 4. Click Create
 - The new passage will open; you can then add a citation to the passage

Add a passage to a definition

- 1. Open the term in the editor view
- 2. Click **Definitions**, then the **View icon** next to the definition that needs a passage
 - The view icon looks like a magnifying glass
 - The full definition will open
- 3. Click Passages, then New Passage
 - The passage entry form will open
- 4. Enter the text of the passage
- 5. Click Create
 - The new passage will open; you can then add a citation to the passage
